To support young people in overcoming social and emotional barriers through creative and innovative programs centering on prevention, intervention, treatment, training and compassion.



KIDS ON THE BLOCK (KOB), a program of **STARS**, educates students in grades K-4 about health and social concerns that affect their lives. Using puppets and other teaching tools, KOB promotes understanding and acceptance of all children and adults, regardless of their differences.

KOB LITERACY PROGRAM

This six-week literacy program targets those students whose proficiency is 10% to 15% behind, and works with them to help increase reading scores through an assortment of activities including a presentation with the Kids on the Block puppets.
