
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KIDS ON THE BLOCK (KOB), a program of **STARS**, educates students in grades K-4 about health and social concerns that affect their lives. Using puppets and other teaching tools, KOB promotes understanding and acceptance of all children and adults, regardless of their differences.

KOB LITERACY PROGRAM

This six-week literacy program targets those students whose proficiency is 10 to 15 percent behind, and works with them to help increase reading scores through an assortment of activities including a presentation with the Kids on the Block puppets.

KOB PRESENTATIONS

KINDERGARTEN:

TEASING AND NAME-CALLING

Discourages teasing and name-calling that can lead to future bullying, while encouraging kindness. (25 minutes)

FIRST GRADE:

AWARENESS OF DIFFERENCES

Promotes respect, understanding and acceptance of all individuals regardless of their differences. (45 minutes)

SECOND GRADE:

SAFE SCHOOLS PROGRAM: Stand Up! Empowering Students To Resolve Conflict and Report Bullving

Teaches that there is more than one way to solve a problem and how to safely intervene in a bullying situation. (45 minutes)

THIRD GRADE:

CHILD-ABUSE PREVENTION

Educates students to identify child abuse and neglect, empowers them to say "No!" and encourages them to talk to a trusted adult. (Recommended 60 minutes)

FOURTH GRADE:

BE A HERO

Designed to examine the challenges around prejudiced thinking and bullying. (60 minutes)
